

Construction Notice

Dear Homeowner:

As part of the 2015 North Grenville Capital Budget, rehabilitation for the asphalt roadway and installation of a pedestrian pathway is planned for your neighborhood. Work is scheduled to begin at the end of July 2015 and will last approximately two weeks.

The Public Works Department is to provide a safe and effective travel space for motorists, pedestrians and bicyclists while maintaining proper drainage and accessibility to the roadway. The rehabilitation of Concession Road will take place between Dr. Gordon Drive and Hurd Road (See Appendix 1 – Road Rehabilitation). The sidewalk will run on the north side of the roadway, but separated from the roadway, similar to the existing sidewalk running in front of South Branch Elementary School, within the road allowance. The proposed sidewalk will be an extension of the existing sidewalk and will run from the entrance of the North Grenville District High School to Hurd Road (See Appendix 2 – Sidewalk Installation). These projects are part of the North Grenville Strategic Plan, Section 5.7 – Transportation.

It is of utmost importance to prevent any disturbances of the surrounding area and to respect property boundaries. This being said, construction will create some inconvenience for home owners. You will have full access, with temporary interruptions, to your home during the construction process.
