The Municipality of North Grenville is embarking on a
"Community Clean-Up NG" initiative

Commencing May 1st to October 15th, Municipal officials will be driving throughout the community searching for violations to its Yards By-Law and Property Standards By-Law, such as the following:

- garbage on porches
- lands that are untidy or unsightly
- open storage of garbage and waste, including junk, debris, rubble, rubbish, litter, household appliances and furniture, and trash
- unmaintained yards, including grass and weeds that are not in conformity with locally accepted standards
- unregistered vehicles not in operating condition
- other conditions that reflect the deterioration of the lands or inadequate maintenance

If any of the above conditions are present on property you own, you are advised to remedy such situation as soon as possible.

If necessary, the Municipality will remedy the code violation itself and add the cost for doing so to your tax bill. Serious and consistent code enforcement is necessary for maintaining property values and the overall appearance of the Municipality, therefore, your co-operation will be greatly appreciated.
