## **Mobility Master Plan**

### **The Study**

The Municipality of North Grenville is updating the 2019 Transportation Master Plan (TMP) and the 2019 Commuter Cycling Plan, while developing an Active Transportation Plan (ATP). The TMP Update and ATP, collectively known as the Mobility Master Plan (MMP), will direct the Municipality's policies and infrastructure investments to support current and projected population growth with an increased focus on sustainability and active transportation solutions. The goal of the MMP is to ensure present and future needs are met by applying an accessible, equitable, environmentally, and economically responsible lens to planning and implementation. This plan will work to ensure all users can be safely and efficiently accommodated, as the community grows and moves together.

### **The Process**

The MMP is being carried out in accordance with phase one and two of the master plan process outlined in the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011, 2015, 2023, and 2024), which is an approved process under the Environmental Assessment Act. This notice signals the commencement of the MMP Study.

### **Get Involved**

Public consultation and engagement is a key component in the development of the MMP. Throughout the process there will be opportunities for residents, Indigenous communities, stakeholders, and agencies to provide input and comments that will influence the direction the Municipality takes.
