Construction Notice

Dear Homeowner:

As part of the 2015 North Grenville Capital Budget, rehabilitation of the asphalt roadway surface and installation of a paved shoulder is planned for your neighborhood. Work is scheduled to begin during the week of September 28th, 2015 and will last approximately three weeks.

The Public Works Department will provide a safe and effective travel space for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists while maintaining proper drainage and accessibility to the roadway. The rehabilitation of River Road will take place between County Road 44 and Settlers Way (See Appendix 1 – Road Rehabilitation).

The works which are planned include:


- 1) Removal of the existing asphalt surface
- 2) Reconstruction and rehabilitation of existing base course
- 3) Adjustment of the existing drainage ditch (where applicable)
- 4) Repaving of asphalt driving surface
- 5) Addition of paved, asphalt shoulders

It is of utmost importance to minimize any disturbances and to respect property boundaries when completing the work. This being said, construction will create some inconvenience for home owners. Residents will continue to have full access, with temporary interruptions, to their property during the construction process.

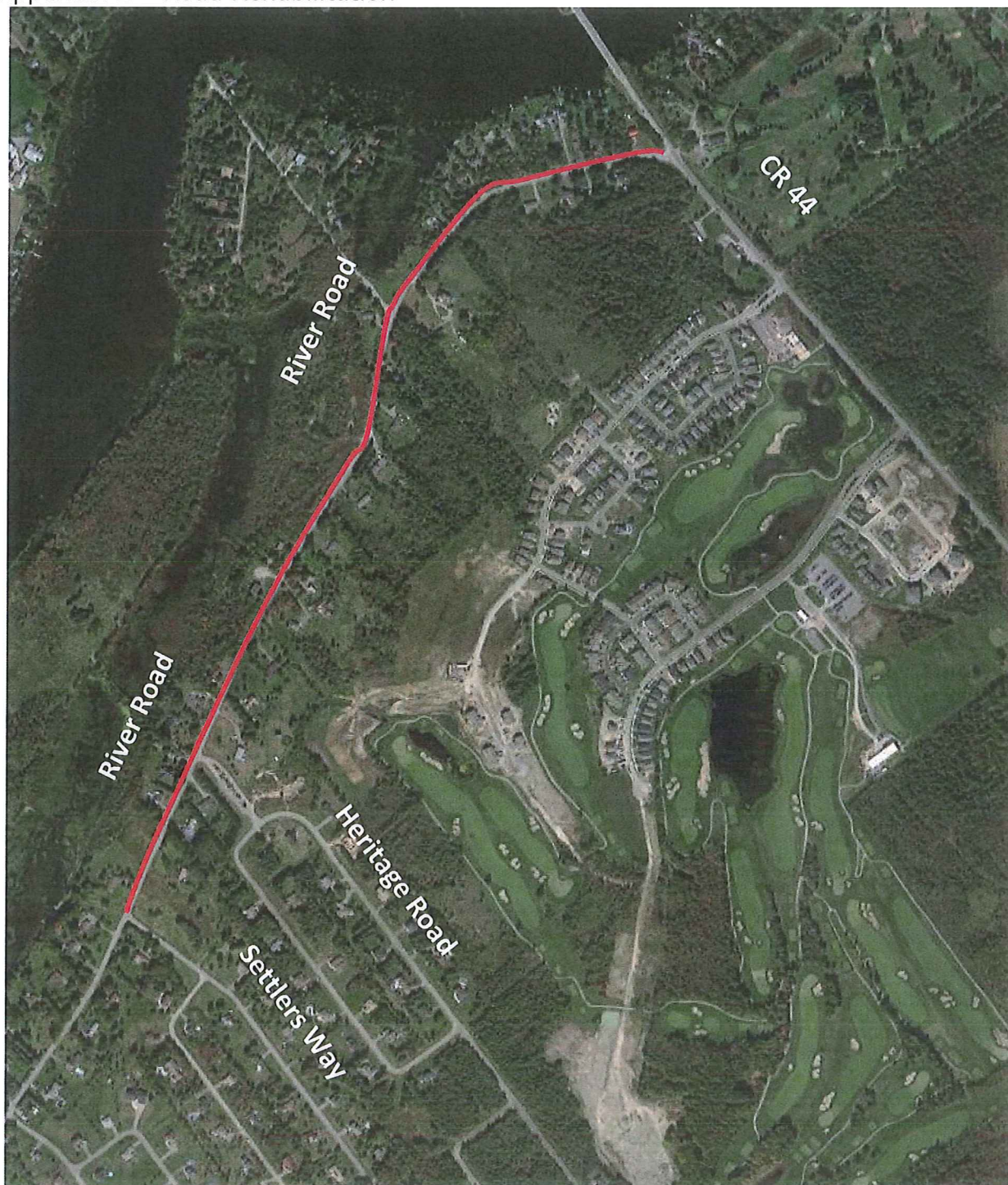
