Quasimodo isn't the only one captivated by her free spirit. The handsome Captain Phoebus and Frollo are equally enthralled. As the three vie for her attention, Frollo embarks on a mission to destroy the gypsies - and it's up to Quasimodo to save them all. A sweeping score and powerful story make *The Hunchback of Notre Dame* an instant classic. Audiences will be swept away by the magic of this truly unforgettable musical.

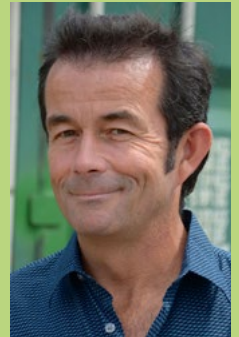
